



Lampeter and District Motor Club Championship Rules 2018

1. RALLYING

- 1.1 All Championships run from Annual Awards Dinner in one year to the last Sunday prior to the Annual Awards Dinner in the following year.
- 1.2 To be eligible for Club Championship points or best Lampeter and District Motor Club crew award a competitor must:
 - a. Be a fully paid up member of Lampeter and District Motor Club.
 - b. Enter under Lampeter and District Motor Club – if more than one club is used on the entry, the first club down must be LDMC – whichever club is down on the “finals” list will be taken as final. If there are any disputes then a copy of the entry form must be produced with a letter from the Clerk of the Course stating this.
- 1.3 The Road Rally Championship will consist of 11 nominated rounds, with competitor’s 7 best scores to count.
- 1.4 The Tarmac Rally Championship will consist of 11 nominated rounds, with competitor’s 7 best scores to count.
- 1.5 The Forest Rally Championships will include any round of the Welsh National Forest Championship
- 1.6 Both Tarmac and Forest Championships will include both modern and historic events.
- 1.7 The number of scoring events in the Forest championship will be the total number of events held in the championship less 3.
- 1.8 If any championship event is cancelled no substitution may be made.
- 1.9 If championship events are cancelled reducing the rounds to 8, then 7 rounds will count. If another event is cancelled reducing the rounds to 7, then 6 rounds will count, then 6 with 5 to count.
- 1.10 If less than 6 rounds are run then all rounds shall count, down to a minimum of 3 rounds. Should less than 3 rounds run in any championship, that particular championship shall be null and void. However points gained on any round will still count towards the overall club championship award, and best Lampeter crew awards shall also be given for that particular event, despite the championship being cancelled.
- 1.11 The points in the championship events are as follows:-
- 1.12 15, 12, 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, and after 9th place every finisher will receive 2 points.
- 1.13 Any competitor passing MC1 but not finishing the event will receive 1 point.
- 1.14 Class winners on any championship event will be awarded 1 bonus point.
- 1.15 Overall winners on any championship event will be awarded 2 bonus points, but forfeit class win bonus points.
- 1.16 Points will be awarded to the individual events, but in the event of a tiebreak at the end of the season, the competitor with most maximum scores will win, if still tied the most seconds and so on until a winner is found. If there is still a tie at the end of this process the “furthest cleanest” wins. i.e. the person who scores highest first. This system will also be used in the event of needing to decide the Best Lampeter crew on any event.
- 1.17 Points will be awarded as per “finals” list. i.e. if a competitor enters as a driver, they will receive points for driving.

- 1.18 To be awarded championship points, competitors must inform the Competition Secretary of their participation by the second meeting after the particular event. Failure to do so may result in those points being forfeited.
- 1.19 In the Road Rally championship any competitor entering the Rali Bro Caron, will not be eligible to score points on the Sarn Helen Rally.
- 1.20 Championship points will be declared final on the night of the last Sunday prior to the Annual Awards Dinner.

2. AWARDS IN RALLYING CHAMPIONSHIPS

- 2.1 Best Lampeter and District Motor Club crew award on all the championship rounds.
- 2.2 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall Driver and Navigator for Road rallies at the end of the championship.
- 2.3 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall Driver and Navigator for Tarmac rallies at the end of the championship.
- 2.4 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall Driver and Navigator for Forest rallies at the end of the championship.
- 2.5 Best 1400cc Driver and Navigator awards for the highest score from any of the championships.
- 2.6 Best Lady competitor – the lady who has accumulated the most points in any of the championship events.
- 2.7 Best Competitor 21 years and under – This will be awarded to the competitor who has accumulated the most points in all championships throughout the year, in any capacity, and is 21 or under on the 1st January of that particular year, so born anytime on or after 1st January 1997
- 2.8 Best competitor on events outside the UK mainland – competitor who has accumulated most points on events outside the UK mainland.

3. DRIVING SKILLS TEST

- 3.1 All competitors must be paid up members of Lampeter and District Motor Club.
- 3.2 All rounds of the LDMC Driving Skills Test will be carried out as per Section D of the Motor Sports Association Blue Book – Specific Regulations for Autotests.
- 3.3 **AWARDS IN DRIVING SKILLS CHAMPIONSHIP**
- 3.4 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall driver.
- 3.5 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall Junior driver - (14 years of age on or after the 1st January of that particular year, and 16 years or under on the date of the Annual Awards Dinner)
- 3.6 1st, 2nd and 3rd Senior Driver.

4. ALL ROUNDER AWARD

- 4.1 This will be awarded to the competitor who has accumulated the most points in all championships throughout the year, in any capacity.
