FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Your rally number is as per the Final Seeded Entry List which can be seen here:

www.ldmc.org.uk

Your start time will be displayed on the noticeboard at Signing On.

Please see the 'Map Collection Times' which will be displayed on the noticeboard at Signing On.

Please see the maps at the end of this document for the location of Noise Check, Scrutineering and Signing On.

Please note the following additions and amendments to the Supplementary Regulations:

1. Officials

Steward **DELETE:** Aled Davies

ADD: Dyfan Davies

2. Fuel

Fuel will be available until **20:00 hrs** at **DD Evans & Sons Ltd, Troedrhwiw Garage**, Lampeter (**MR 146 / 576.5 488**). Fuel will also be available here from 09:00 hrs Sunday morning if needed.

Please ensure you have enough fuel to cover **70 miles**. Super unleaded petrol will **NOT** be available at the fuel halt.

3. Trailers

Competitors bringing their cars on trailers are advised that there **WILL** be a trailer park available **AT YOUR OWN RISK**. It will be located near Gwili Jones & Sons, Maesyfelin Business Park, Lampeter, SA48 8LS (**MR 146 / 579.75 489.25**).

Trailers will **NOT** be permitted to enter the rally car park, Noise Check area or Scrutineering venue.

4. Noise Check

Proceed towards **Unit 21, Lampeter Industrial Estate, Tregaron Road, Lampeter, SA48 8LT** for Noise Check, which will **open at 17:00 hrs**.

5. Scrutineering

Scrutineering will be located at **Protyre, Huw Lewis Tyres, Lampeter** and will open at **17:00 hrs** and close at **20:45 hrs (MR 146/ 576.25 488.5)**.

We would like to remind competitors that **ONLY** the competing car and the driver and navigator may present the car at both Noise Check and Scrutineering.

Competitors are reminded that vehicles must have a valid MOT and be taxed, and both must be available for inspection at Scrutineering if requested. Any vehicles without a valid MOT and Tax will not be permitted to start the event, and the crew **will not** be refunded their entry fee.

6. Car Park

On completion of Noise Check and Scrutineering, proceed through Lampeter to the rally car park at the **Rookery Car Park** where you will be guided to your allocated slot (**MR 146 / 574.5 481**).

7. Signing On

Make your way on foot to the reception of Ysgol Bro Pedr. Signing On will open at **17:00 hrs and close at 21:00 hrs (MR 146 / 575 481)**.

All outstanding monies paid by **CASH ONLY**. Please familiarise yourselves with the relevant sections of the Supplementary Regulations regarding non-production of licences, applications for licences and event insurance.

After Signing On, competitors will receive a Rally Pack containing rally plates, timecards and other relevant information.

Competitors on the Reserve List are reminded of the following:

Allocation of entries from the Reserves List from publication of the Official Entry List, up to the start of Signing On at 17.00 hrs on Saturday 7th March 2026, will be as per the order on the Entry List.

After this time allocation of reserves will take place on the hour every hour from the start of Signing On, i.e. 18:00, 19:00, 20:00 and 21:00 hrs, and finally 21:30. Priority will be given to reserves that are physically present at the allocated times, have attended and passed Noise Check and Scrutineering, have signed on as Reserve Entries at the relevant desk, and have their marshal present and ready to sign on. Allocation of reserves will then be in order of time of signing on, and NOT as per order on the Entry List.

i.e. **FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED ON THE EVENING.**

The fine for non-production of a licence for 2026 is **£41**, as per NCR Chapter 6, Appendix 1, Article 12.2.

Competitors are required to hold possession of a valid Interclub Competition Licence. You may **NOT** apply for a licence at Signing On.

NO CASH will be accepted by signing on officials in respect of fines for non-production of licences. Cheque only.

8. Maps

All competitors will need the latest edition of **Ordnance Survey Maps 146 & 159** (1:50 000 series latest edition). **The Basic Roamer Co.** will be in attendance on the night and can supply maps and other navigation equipment if required.

9. Marshals

Please be aware that the stipulation **no marshal no start will be strictly enforced**. **All competitors must sign on a marshal**. This is regardless of whether all the controls may have been filled.

Competitors who are unable to supply a marshal, irrespective of their location and distance travelled to come to the event, **will be turned away** at Signing On. This may seem harsh, **but there will be NO EXCEPTIONS**. Please do not ask us to relax this rule, as refusal often offends.

Marshals will be expected to wear **reflective clothing**, which should be supplied by either the marshal themselves or by their competitor. A limited supply will be available to purchase at Signing On.

Please remind your marshals not to litter!

Please make your marshal aware of their requirement to open their control on time, or risk exclusion of their crew.

Controls that have been pre-booked with the Chief Marshal will be kept until 19:30 hrs only. After this time, they will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

10. Damage

All competitors are reminded that it is their duty to report any damage caused to third party property, no matter how insignificant they feel it might be. This can be detailed on the Damage Declaration Form and handed in at MC4, or for competitors who retire, within 48 hours of results going final.

Competitors that have been involved in an accident should act as outlined below.

Section 170 Road Traffic Act 1988

DUTY OF DRIVER TO STOP, REPORT ACCIDENT AND GIVE INFORMATION OR DOCUMENTS

1. This section applies in a case where, owing to the presence of a mechanically propelled vehicle on a road, an accident occurs by which –
 - a. personal injury is caused to a person other than the driver of that mechanically propelled vehicle, or
 - b. damage is caused –
 - i. to a vehicle other than that mechanically propelled vehicle or a trailer drawn by that mechanically propelled vehicle, or
 - ii. to an animal other than an animal in or on that mechanically propelled vehicle or a trailer drawn by that mechanically propelled vehicle, or
 - iii. to any other property constructed on, fixed to, growing in or otherwise forming part of the land on which the road in question is situated or land adjacent to such land
2. The driver of the mechanically propelled vehicle must stop and, if required to do so by any person having reasonable grounds for so requiring, give his name and address and also the name and address of the owner and the identification marks of the vehicle.
3. If for any reason the driver of the mechanically propelled vehicle does not give his name and address under subsection (2) above, he must report the accident.
4. A person who fails to comply with subsection (2) or (3) above is guilty of an offence.
5. If, in a case where this section applies by virtue of subsection (1)(a) above, the driver of a motor vehicle does not at the time of the accident produce such a certificate of insurance or security, or other evidence, as is mentioned in section 165(2) of this Act –
 - a. to a constable, or
 - b. to some person who, having reasonable grounds for so doing, has required him to produce it, the driver must report
 - c. the accident and produce such a certificate or other evidence. This subsection does not apply to the driver of an invalid carriage.
6. To comply with a duty under this section to report an accident or to produce such a certificate of insurance or security, or other evidence, as is mentioned in section 165(2)(a) of certificate of insurance or security, or other evidence, as is mentioned in section 165(2)(a) of this Act, the driver –
 - a. must do so at a police station or to a constable, and
 - b. must do so as soon as is reasonably practicable and, in any case, within twenty-four hours of the occurrence of the accident

7. A person who fails to comply with a duty under section (5) above is guilty of an offence, but he shall not be convicted by reason only of a failure to produce a certificate or other evidence if, within seven days after the occurrence of the accident, the certificate or other evidence is produced at a police station that was specified by him at the time when the accident was reported.
8. In this section "animal" means horse, cattle, ass, mule, sheep, pig, goat or dog.

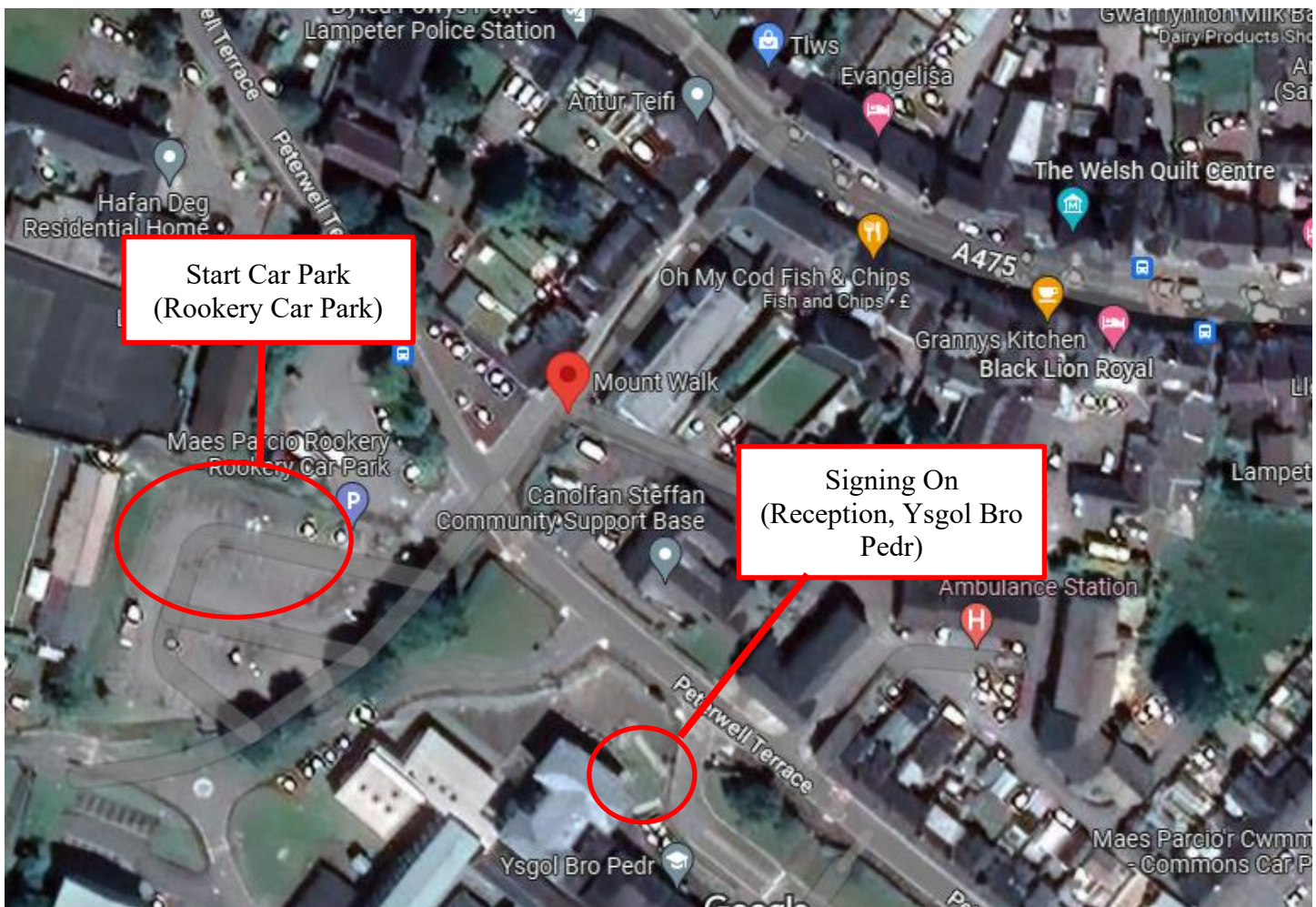
Rule 286 – Highway Code

If you are involved in a collision which causes damage or injury to any other person, vehicle, animal or property, you **MUST**:

- stop
- give your own and the vehicle owner's name and address, and the registration number of the vehicle, to anyone who has reasonable grounds for requiring them
- if you do not give your name and address at the time of the collision, report it to the police as soon as reasonably practicable, and in any case, within 24 hours.
